



2024 survey on camping plans French campers

Are you curious about where French campers want to go on holiday in 2024? ACSI conducted a survey on the French campers' holiday plans for 2024. We present the results to you now.

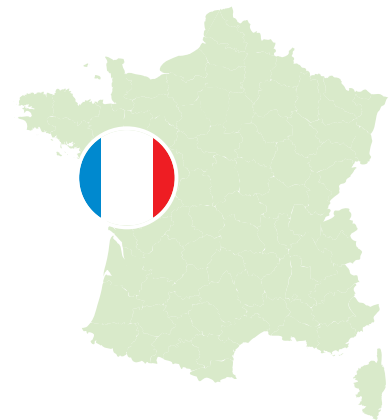
For this survey, we asked more than 1,700 French campers about their plans. We approached them through ACSI's European websites and newsletters. Campers could take part between 6 February to 7 March.

Average number of camping holidays in 2024

French campers who usually go camping with children/grandchildren plan to go camping an average of five times in 2024. They will go camping for a total of 42 days. Campers who usually go camping in a different composition plan to go camping about eight times a year. They spread that over 71 days and that is a considerable increase compared to 2023 when campers planned to go camping for 61 days.

These countries are popular

This year again, domestic holidays and Spain are popular destinations among French campers, followed by Italy and Portugal. French campers with children in particular choose to go camping in their own country more often, whereas there was a decrease last year compared to 2022, we now seen an increase again.
